| Position | Description |
|---|--|
| Small Group Discussion Leaders & Helpers | One or two adults for each table to ask thought-provoking questions related to the subject in order to start discussion of the topic. Leader manual with questions provided. |
| Meal Coordinator | Responsible for coordinating donations of main & side dish, desserts, and drinks for each session. |
| Extras | Set up and Cleanup crew, Technology, Greeters, etc. |

Youth Alpha

| Position | Description |
|---|--|
| Speakers | Mature teens or young adults who currently have a relationship with Jesus. Two or three individuals would share this responsibility. Speakers would use PowerPoint presentations and movie clips (provided) along with their personal experience on the subject to present each week's topics. |
| Small Group Discussion Leaders & Helpers | Two young people for each table to ask thought-provoking questions related to the talk in order to start discussion of the topic. Sheets with discussion questions are provided. |
| Worship Music Team | Teenagers or young adults who sing and/or play an instrument are needed to play contemporary Christian music at each session. |
| Games and Social Coordinators | Coordinate games, ice breakers, and social aspects for each session |
| Extras | Technology, Greeters, Food, Set up & Cleanup crew, etc. |
